Koala Park

Koalas are fussy eaters. They eat 50 species of the 600 species of eucalyptus trees in Australia. The belief that the koala is drunk on these leaves is actually a myth. Eucalyptus leaves contain 50% water and 5% sugars and starches. This is a low energy diet therefore they conserve their energy by sleeping about 19 hours a day, which makes them appear intoxicated.

Wombats are one of the largest burrowing animals in the world, weighing up to 40 kgs—**Meet A WOMAT!**

Kangaroos and wallabies belong to a group of animals called macropods. They have powerful legs that act like springs, big feet to help them hop and a long tail to help them balance.
