Launch of Intel KMCO and IIMGP Payout

Intel launched its Kulim Microprocessor and Chipset Operations (KMCO), a USD230 million (RM805 mil) investment within Malaysia's Kulim Hi-Tech Park on Dec 15, 2009. In conjunction with the launch, Intel contributed RM1.85 million to the local community generated from its Intel Involved Matching Grant Program (IIMGP). The fund was a result of over 130,000 volunteer hours from Intel employees.

Underlining our commitment towards environmental sustainability, Intel volunteers organized its fifth consecutive annual Mangrove Tree Planting activity in November 2009. To date, 10000 mangrove saplings have been planted since the initiative first started in 2005.
