## *New Intel® Teach Credit towards ICT Masters*

For two years, Charles Sturt University have been awarding 25% credit to teachers who have completed the Intel Teach Essentials and / or Thinking with Technology courses - towards the Graduate Certificate in ICT Education. CSU are now introducing a *new* Masters in ICT in Education starting in 2012, and have confirmed that teachers who have completed Intel Teach Essentials or Thinking with Technology courses will be awarded credit for one subject towards the Masters.

*NB: Intel Teach Scholarships are also available for both the Masters and the Graduate Certificate – closing date for applications 1 December.*
